**Applicant Ownership Information**

Pegasus Development Corporation (“PDC”) is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Pegasus Communications Corporation (“PCC”).

PCC’s Class A Common Stock represents approximately 33.6% of the voting rights of this company and is held by public shareholders. Pegasus Communications Holdings, Inc. (“PCHI”), PCC’s parent company, holds Class B Common Stock representing approximately 48.4% of the voting rights in PCC. This figure includes the voting rights held by Pegasus Northwest Offer Corporation and Pegasus Scranton Offer Corporation each of which holds Class B Common Stock representing approximately 2% of the voting rights in PCC. Pegasus Capital, L.P., an entity controlled by Marshall W. Pagon, holds the remainder of the Class B Common Stock of PCC, representing approximately 18% of the voting rights in PCC. Pegasus Capital, L.P. has a single corporate general partner, Pegasus Capital, Ltd. The stock of that corporation is owned 100% by Marshall W. Pagon.

As indicated above, PCHI controls PCC. The voting stock of PCHI is held by a limited partnership, Pegasus Communications Limited Partnership (“PCLP”). PCLP is controlled by its general partner, Northwest Management Associates, L.P. (“NMALP”). The limited partners of PCLP and NMALP are insulated.<sup>1</sup> NMALP has a single partner, Pegasus Cable Associates, Ltd., a corporation owned 100% by Marshall W. Pagon.

<sup>1</sup> Among the insulated limited partners of PCLP and NMALP are other limited partnerships in which certain officers, directors and employees of the operating companies hold equity interests. Among these are Marshall W. Pagon, whose interests are already attributable. To the extent that other individuals due to their involvement in day-to-day operations have interests that are attributable, all hold less than 1 % of the equity of PCLP or NMALP, and cumulatively hold less than 5%.

Thus, as set forth above, through his control of PCHI and Pegasus Capital, L.P., Marshall Pagon controls approximately 66.4% of the voting stock of PCC, and has actual control of that corporation.

### **Other Interests**

PDC has applied for a license to launch and operate a satellite system operating in the Ka band to provide fixed satellite services.

PCC, the direct parent of PDC, wholly owns Pegasus Satellite Communications, Inc., which in turn wholly owns Pegasus Media & Communications, Inc. Pegasus Media & Communications, Inc. is the parent of Pegasus Broadcast Television, Inc. (“PBT”), whose principal business is the provision of commercial broadcast television. PBT, in turn, is the direct parent of various subsidiaries that hold FCC licenses for television stations. Specifically, PBT is the parent company of: (1) WOLF License Corp., licensee of WOLF-TV, Hazleton, Pennsylvania; (2) Pegasus Broadcast Associates, L.P.<sup>2</sup>, licensee of WILF(TV), Williamsport, Pennsylvania; (3) WDSI License Corp., licensee of WDSI-TV, Chattanooga, Tennessee; (4) WDBD License Corp., licensee of WDBD(TV), Jackson, Mississippi; (5) WTLH License Corp.<sup>3</sup>, licensee of WTLH(TV), Bainbridge, Georgia; and (6) HMW, Inc.<sup>4</sup>, licensee of WPXT(TV), Portland, Maine.

<sup>2</sup> PBT is the parent company of WILF, Inc., the general partner of Pegasus Broadcast Associates, L.P. PBT is the sole limited partner.

<sup>3</sup> PBT is the parent company of WTLH, Inc.. which wholly owns WTLH License Corp.

<sup>4</sup> PBT is the parent company of Bride Communications, Inc.. Bride wholly owns HMW, Inc.

Pegasus Satellite Communications, Inc. also wholly owns Pegasus Guard Band, LLC, which is the licensee of 31 Guard Band Manager licenses in the 700 MHz band for various markets in the U.S.

Pegasus Capital, L.P., which holds 18% of the voting rights in PCC, holds a 10 percent or greater interest in two FCC-licensed entities, Pegasus Communications Portfolio Holdings, Inc. and Pegasus IVDS, Inc. Pegasus Communications Portfolio Holdings, Inc.'s principal business is implementing the provision of multipoint multichannel distribution services and it holds several MMDS licenses. Pegasus IVDS, Inc.'s principal business is implementing the provision of interactive video data services and it holds IVDS licenses for several markets in the United States.

In addition, Pegasus Communications Corporation is an independent distributor of DirecTV's DBS service, with the exclusive right to distribute the service to over 7.2 million rural households in 41 states.
