The following additional information has been provided to AFTRCC by Calspan Corporation for Renewal and Modification of Ground Station Authorization WGC9 and should be reflected on their FCC application:

Ground Elevation above Mean Sea Level at the antenna site: 194.6 meters

Maximum height of the tip of the antenna Above Ground Level: 5.9 meters

AFTRCC recommends the FCC add the following restriction(s) to the grant of this authorization:


