The Namakagon Lake area is being threatened with a 400' cell tower with blinking strobe lights causing light pollution that will be highly visible to a sacred land that should be protected land which has been named after Chief Namakagon.

Chief Namakagon (AKA Mikwam-miqwan or "Old Ice Feathers") was an Anishinaabe leader and sole resident of Lake Namakagon in Bayfield County, Wisconsin from the early 1830's through 1886.

We the residents of Lake Namakagon need your help to stop this 400' commercial cell tower from being installed in a highly visible spot seen by all. It can be installed lower and in a concealed area where nobody sees it and hence would not ruin the natural beauty of this sacred area.

You can stop the present installation by Norvado Telephone Company—put a hold on all 400' cell tower plans until a new site is found. We need your help.


In addition, Namakagon Lake is the headwater for the Namakagon River which has been designated as a Wild River—all 101 miles have been protected.

The Namakagon River flows into the St. Croix River which has been declared a National Scenic Riverway by the National Park Services—all 144 miles have been protected with this designation.

This 255 miles of river waterway is a national treasure for future generations.

Dear Mr. Carter:

Please be advised your proposed 400' cell tower location, at the Namakagon transfer site is totally unacceptable.

We purchased a special 4' weather balloon from a Connecticut Weather Station and had it filled in Hayward with helium.

We flew this balloon from your surveyor's designated cell tower site 400' in the air.

The high visibility of this balloon representing a 400' cell tower from all the homes on Garden Lake and Namakagon Lake east of County Road D condemns the rural country atmosphere that originally attracted all who originally invested in the above mentioned area.

The enclosed map clearly points to a proposed cell tower site on public land owned by everyone that has no commercial impact on all who came to the Namakagon area for its rural country beauty.

Further and extremely important this proposed site affords greater and more efficient cell tower coverage due to its closer location to County Road D. In addition this proposed site is on top of a hill.

We, the public, own the Chequamegon Forest and the proposed location off Highway M halfway between the Namakagon Town Hall and Forest Road 203 is ideal.

This letter is to demand you cease and desist from further efforts to perfect your present proposed site while we work with the Chequamegon Forest personnel to develop the correct cell tower site as outlined in the enclosed map.

Finally we would prefer maintaining amiable relations but if necessary we are prepared to resort to litigation in order to preserve our rural atmosphere and the very reasons we came to the Namakagon area.

The enclosed article to Dave Carter, Manager of Norvado, and Dan Anderson, his assistant, is self-explanatory.


Congratulations! You will have a front row seat to view the 400' cell tower with strobe lights blinking all night.

Off County Road M halfway between Namakagon Town Hall and Forest Road 203 is an excellent location for this cell tower.


Reasons for this location are:

The correct site is just off Highway M on the South side of the road halfway between the Namakagon Town Hall and Forest Road 203.


This site is ideal for the following reasons:
