

Exhibit A – Supplemental Information

Indirect Ownership

Emery Telcom-Wireless, Inc. (Applicant), a Utah corporation, is owned by Emery Telcom HC, Inc., a holding company, which in turn is owned by Emery Telephone d/b/a Emery Telcom. Emery Telephone is organized as a rural telephone cooperative in Orangeville, Utah. Membership in the cooperative is acquired by subscribing to its telephone service. No one individual or entity owns as much as ten percent of Emery Telephone.

Exemption from Attributable Revenues

Applicant certifies that it qualifies for the exception in Rule Section 1.2110(b)(3)(iii) from including any business revenues of its officers and directors in Applicant's attributable revenues. Applicant thus certifies that it is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Emery Telcom HC, Inc., which in turn is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Emery Telephone, which: (1) is organized as a cooperative pursuant to Utah law; (2) is a rural telephone company as defined by the Communications Act; and (3) is eligible for tax-exempt status under the Internal Revenue Code and that it adheres to the cooperative principles articulated in *Puget Sound Plywood, Inc. v. Commissioner of Internal Revenue*, 44 T.C. 305 (1965).

Attributable Material Relationships

Applicant certifies, in accordance with Section 1.2112(b)(1)(iii) of the Commission's Rules, that it has no attributable material relationships. In particular, Applicant has no arrangements for the lease or resale (including wholesale agreements) of any of the capacity of Applicant's licensed spectrum.

Ethical Wall

Applicant utilizes a law firm that represents other applicants in Auction 97. Members of Applicant's law firm have been authorized to perform bidding duties on behalf of other Auction 97 applicants. Applicant's law firm has not been involved in any discussions regarding bids or bid strategies and will not perform bidding duties for any other client/applicant that has specified licenses on its short-form application that are the same or that have geographic overlap with those of Applicant. Moreover, procedures have been implemented to ensure that the law firm's other clients/applicants cannot learn of any information about Applicant's bids or bid strategies or plans for the post-auction market structure, and *vice versa*.
