ANTENNA STRUCTURE REGISTRATION PUBLIC NOTICE

CTI Towers Assets II, LLC ("CTI") has filed an application with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") to register an existing, 90-foot tall guyed telecommunications tower that was recently acquired by CTI. The existing telecommunications tower is located at Sky Line Drive between S 530 Road and Ridge Road, Bernice, Delaware County, OK (36° 37' 42.01" N/94° 55' 32.08" W). No expansion or modification to the existing telecommunications tower is being proposed in connection with this application. FAA obstruction lighting is not required for the existing telecommunications tower. The purpose of this application is to simply register a previously unregistered tower structure with the FCC. 
